

Climate Change Meeting – 17th Oct 2020

- **Dec 2020** - Yellow rattle planting near to main entrance to WM and entrances to village. Clear brambles first to plant yellow rattle.
- **Nov 2020** - WM bramble cut and bring wildflowers 15th and 29th November 11-4 spend an hour or all day. Bring a spade and gloves.
- **Dec 2020** - Log Pile for insect to use near brambles between first and second field of Webbers Meadow. Add signage so walkers are aware what the logs are for.
- **Oct 2020** - Next council meeting, ask if Parish Council can contact Devon Highway and ask if planters can be put under the entrances to village signs? This would make it easier to grow wildflowers and maintain.
 - **TBC** - Ted happy to contact The Bye Meadow for an idea of year on year maintenance on wildflowers.
 - **TBC** - Foxglove planting - Gill has some saplings of which she can spare
 - **Nov 2020** - Ragwort could stay as wild flower but would need to be kept in control as to not allow to take over.
 - **Dec 2020** - Obtain wood chips to lay around the whips to help protect and grow.
 - **TBC** - Trees for the church graveyard.
 - **Dec/Jan** - Bat boxes, Bird boxes, Bee boxes Spring 2021. Toby Taylor - Back Lane will make bird and bat boxes for £5
 - **TBC** - Can we use an admin drop box on the parish website to keep Climate Change Group in touch?
