## **Report to Newton Poppleford and Harpford Parish Council**

I'm sorry that I am unable to attend this month's meeting as I am away on Monday evening (it's still half term for one of my children).

Here are the key items for me to report:

1. As you will be aware the section 19 report into the flooding in the Otter Valley on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023 has been published and the parish council has I believe already received a copy. - 2. I attended the Community Resilience Meeting on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October at the Pavillion in Newton Poppleford. A big thank you for to Newton Poppleford Parish Council for arranging this event and providing refreshments. It was extremely well attended with I estimate around 70 people including members of the public and parish councillors from this and neighbouring parishes. I was interested to hear speakers from both Devon Communities together and Lympstone flood group on the subject of flood plans, as well as the Environment Agency talking about natural flood management solutions.
- **3.** I have pressed DCC highways (again) for an update on the completion of the wig wag installation and signage once I have more information I will get back to you.
