<p><b>1.Election of Chairman for the Meeting</b></p> <p>Cllr Burhop – nominated. Proposed Cllr Jeffery Agreed. Unan.</p>

<p><b>3. Minutes of the Meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2015</b> were approved and signed.</p> <p>Proposed Cllr Kemp Seconded Cllr Downen. Unan.</p>	
<p><b>4. Applications for Planning Permission received</b></p> <p>a)15/1664/FUL – Fairlea, Southerton Proposal: -Bedroom ensuite and boot room extension. Observations: - No objections, no impact on any neighbours.</p> <p>b) 15/17/10/FUL - Little Acre, Millmoor Lane, Newton Poppleford, Proposal: - Construction of first floor rear/side extension. Observations: - Site Inspection re. Neighbour. <b>Note – Subsequently the applicant advised he was to withdraw the application.</b></p> <p>c) 15/1196/FUL – 7 Broad Meadow, High Street, Newton Poppleford Proposal: - Construction of Conservatory on front elevation (amended plans). Observations:- No objection, fully support, as in line with Parish Council comments on original application.</p> <p>Proposed Cllr Lipczynski Seconded Cllr Tillotson. Unan.</p>	
<p><b>5. Reports</b></p> <p>It was noted that in respect of the Neighbourhood Plan Community Day, this would be advertised in the parish magazine, website and notice boards. The date is Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September. It was also agreed that a review day in respect of the BAUB Boundary. would be held on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> September in the Pavilion at 10am until 2pm.</p>	

<p>Cllr Burhop updated the meeting in respect of the microphone system, noting that the cost could be in the range from £2,500 thousand down to £1,300 using the existing system with additions for use in other venues.</p> <p>Cllr Burhop then reported further on the concept of the open community day and a firework display on Webber’s Meadow with Bonfire and barbecue and using the Pavilion for a bar etc. Noted the PTA were to help. The cost around £1000.00 for 10 minutes, consideration of dog show and horse grooming to be considered further.</p>
