Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on 31st March 2016
in the Pavilion at 8pm.

<p>Police report. PC Lee apologized for Sergeant Turner not being able to attend, but he was hopeful of doing so at the next meeting. Reference was made to the incident alleged to have taken place in Newton Poppleford toilets and PC Lee confirmed that the Police are continuing to monitor the area but there is no evidence at all that it had ever taken place and it appeared to be a hoax. It was noted that 5 crimes had been reported during the month.(2 Burglaries, 2 thefts, and one of domestic violence. Pc Lee referred to engraving Post Codes on all valuable items, the Police do this as a free service, also they still have available a supply of screeching Padlocks. Mr Slade referred to a person urinating in public, PC Lee said he was aware of this and would have a further word with the individual. He then referred to another “ Big Scene day” where 100 vehicles had been stopped and 12 prohibited from proceeding. Shan Merritt raised the matter of the police and crime commissioners forthcoming Election and enquired if it was considered a necessary post. It was noted that the current one had been helpful to the Sidmouth Police.</p> <p>Cllr Channon. referred to the new School Build and indicated that DCC had not received the plans and were trying to obtain them. The open day for viewing at the school was 14th April. School warning sign, it was considered that this was a matter for the Headmaster to request. Venn Ottery Quarry liaison Committee, note no meetings had been held recently due to an Officers death, but the next one would be notified to VOSRA for a representative to attend. Red Bridge continued considerations are ongoing, costing solutions awaited.</p>

<p>Mr Swan, raised a burning issues item, in respect of the air Ambulance night time operation, pending landing site availability. He suggested offering the use of the Playing Field. Auto lighting would be required as would a landing surface. It was suggested a letter be sent to Air Ambulance control seeking information.</p> <p>Items discussed under Police & DCC. The other contentious item was the matter of the removal of the over grown hedgerow saplings (referred to as trees). VOSRA complained through the deputy chair that notification should have been given to the residents of Venn Ottery. The Clerk was criticized for this reply to one Resident, but stated the Council had decided to proceed after taking advice from three Tree Surgeons in respect of Danger & the loss of light affecting grass growth. It was noted that when it all re-sprouted it would look better (the matter had been fully considered by the finance committee at two meetings). It was agreed that a letter be sent to VOSRA chair man in due course and further consideration be given to communications via the Policy Committee.</p>	A

<p>5. Planning Applications Received</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A) 15/2866/FUL East Hill Pride Farm Shop, Four Elms Hill, Harpford. Proposal: Construction of a dwelling for a Horticultural worker (new site). Members noted this was an update on the previous supported application, but a new site for the property had had been suggested by Officers at EDDC. Councilor Ranger voiced her concern on the matter, the applicant responding to the point raised and previously considered. Resolved to support the new siting with the addition of an agricultural tie being applied. Proposed Cllr M.J. Seconded Cllr J.C. 4-0-3 ABS. B) 15/2615FUL Hillside House, Exeter Road. Proposal: Change of use from Hotel and Restaurant (class C1) to residential care home (class 2) including alterations & extensions. Noted this has previously been supported, more detailed note of the operation for consideration. Resolved to fully support the proposal. Jobs would be created. Under the previous system it was only applied if 15 houses were being built. In the DMC training session it was noted a legal case was ongoing. In our area £125 per sq meter was to be charged.
