Generally crime has gone down a bit with no particularly worrying emerging trends. Of note is the fact that we seem to have no theft from motor vehicles this quarter thanks to the naughty people being locked up.

A3052 continues to be a source of police logs for motoring related incidents with several reported (and unreported) accidents and broken down vehicles.

We have carried out a successful operation Mascot once again in August with a total of 13 offences recorded mostly for defective vehicles or no insurance and 19 motorist given stern words of advice for minor infringements.

We continue our efforts to reduce speeding through the village and have successfully targeted 3 motorcyclists who were riding through with either loud exhaust or in an antisocial manor.

There continues to be an issue with loose horses on the main roads, enquiries are continuing with this matter
