But just in case here is a short report from me.

Crime is up from 2 to 4 for January this year compared to last year there were;

1x theft from motor vehicle at Joney's cross. (Again)!

1x theft of motorcycle from Newton Pop.

1x theft of scrap metal.

1x telecommunications offence which was domestic related.

Despite our best efforts regularly visiting our beauty spot car parks and advising motorists about leaving articles in their cars they continue to do so, the message is simple you will only get your car broken in to if there is something of value on display. We have new notice boards to put up in the next few weeks.

We have been out and about doing speed watch on both School lane and the arterial routes through the village, I have even been getting up extra early to catch and deter speeders on motorcycles on Saturday and Sunday mornings, I think the problem is now resolved.

We are trying to get a bit more "engagement" with our rural community's particularly isolated properties and farms so will hopefully be quite visible over the next few months.

On the road safety theme we as a team are pleased to support the village in its quest for a speed limit reduction on both Four Elms and School Lane together with any other Traffic calming measures that can be introduced, we will continue to assist by preparing reports and attending meetings with the Parrish councillor's when invited to do so.
